

SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

- Read all safety precautions and installation instructions carefully before installing or servicing this fixture. Failure to comply with these instruction could result in potentially fatal electric shock and/or property damage.
- 2. It is recommended that a qualified electrician perform all wiring. This fixture must be wired in accordance with all national and local electrical codes.
- 3. Do not handle any energized fixture or attempt to energize any fixture with wet hands or while standing on a wet or damp surface or in water.
- 4. This fixture is designed for use in a 120VAC, 60Hz fused circuit. This fixture is compatible with 2-wire TRIAC dimmers.
- 5. Make sure that the power source conforms to the requirements of the fixture. (See labels on the fixture housing).
- 6. To reduce the risk of electrical shock, and to assure proper operation, this fixture must be adequately grounded. To accomplish proper grounding, there must be a separate ground wire (green) contact between this fixture and the ground conection of your main power supply panel.
- 7. This fixture is intended to be used for general indoor lighting in dry, damp or wet locations. For wet application, it must be mounted at least 48 inches above the ground level (not suitable for submersion).

INSTRUCTIONS

Step 1 - Preparing for installation.

- 1. Disconnect electrical power at fuse or circuit breker box before installing or servicing any part of this fixture.
- 2. Carefuly remove the fixture from the carton.
- 3. Remove mounting bracket (1) from the fixture.
- 4. Instal screws (3) to mounting bracket alowing only about 7/16" to protrude outward.
- 5. Tighten two center screws on mounting bracket to secure in place.

INSTRUCTIONS

Wiring-All wiring must take place inside junction box (not included).

Caution: Make sure power is off at fuse or circuit breaker box. Check power wires for damage or scrapes. Use wire suitable for at least 90°C (194°F). Have supply wire rated to 60°C.Consult a qualified electrician before installing.

Step 2 - Wiring fixture.

- 1. Connect Supply Wiring.Secure with nuts (provided).
- 2. Connect the green wire from the fixture to the supply ground wire.
- 3. Connect the black wire from the fixture to the black(L) wire from supply.
- 4. Connect the white wire from the fixture to the white(N) wire from supply.
- 5. Tuck all connections neatly into the junction box.

Step 3 - Mounting.

- 1. Install fixture (5) over the mounting bracket (1) by aligning center holes to the stems (3) and secure with barrel nuts (4).
- 2. **IMPORTANT:** Apply a small bead of silicone (not included) per manufacturer's instruction around the perimeter of the fixture (5) where it contacts with the surface of wall.

Step 4 - Restore power at fuse or circuit breaker box.
